# User Guide of 12306 Website/App for Accredited Personnel of Beijing 2022 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games

# **Part 1 Ticketing Service**

#### 1. Overview

The Beijing 2022 section of on the China Railway website (12306.cn) and mobile app is dedicated to providing high-speed railway (HSR) ticketing service to accredited participants of Beijing 2022 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games. On the 12306 website/app, accredited users can book free round-trip HSR tickets between Qinghe and Taizicheng (Chongli)/Yanqing.

The ticketing service is bilingual (English and Chinese) and the 12306 app is accessible on both Android and iOS systems.

# 2. Download, Installation and User Guide of 12306 App

# 2.1 App Download and Installation

#### 2.1.1 For Android and HarmonyOS Systems

Android and HarmonyOS users can search "12306" in the app marketplace to download and install the latest version of 12306 App.

# 2.1.2 For the iOS System

iOS users can download 12306 App from the App Store.

Search "12306" in App Store and click the download button to download and install 12306 App on your iPhone.

# 2.2 User Guide for Accredited Games Participants

# 2.2.1 Registration

Please log in to the Beijing 2022 section of 12306 website or app using your OIAC (Olympic

Identity and Accreditation Card) or PIAC (Paralympic Identity and Accreditation Card) number and full name for verification and registration. Then choose your closed-loop management (CLM) status, fill in the contact information, and proceed to contact information verification.







Enter OIAC/PIAC number, full name, and password for registration







Finish the user registration by choosing your CLM status and providing your contact information before proceeding to book tickets

You may provide either your mobile number or email address as contact information and choose whether to verify it. The verification result will not affect the booking process. For those whose contact information has been verified, a booking notification containing ticket information will be sent upon booking completion via SMS (only in Chinese) or email (only in English).

# 2.2.2 Change Password

After registration, you can change your CLM status, contact information and password in "Me" section.






# 2.2.3 Ticket Booking

After registration and verification, you can book round-trip HSR tickets for trips between Qinghe and Taizicheng (Chongli)/Yanqing. Closed-loop passengers and non-closed-loop passengers cannot book the same train.

The tickets are open to booking starting at 16:00 five days prior to the departure date. Please take the seat as indicated on the train ticket. Each accredited passenger can book only one outbound trip ticket and one return trip ticket per day.













Please follow your transport entitlements below when booking train tickets.

- a. Accredited personnel with transport code T1: business-class, first-class, and second-class seats.
- b. Accredited personnel with transport code T2: first-class and second-class seats.
- c. Accredited personnel with transport codes T3, TA, TF, TP: second-class seats.
- d. Accredited personnel with transport code TM: multi-functional and second-class seats.

#### 2.2.4 Ticket Cancellation

You can cancel the reserved tickets before train departure, unless the ticket has been checked at the boarding gate or the train has departed.







#### 2.2.5 Check-in

a. If you are in the closed-loop areas of the train station, you can show the QR code on the 12306 app to pass the auto boarding gate and proceed to the boarding platform by following the closed-

loop flow line.

b. If you are in the non-closed-loop areas, you need to present both the QR code and your OIAC/PIAC. OIAC/PIAC verification machines, similar to those at Games venues, are used to verify identity.

At the Qinghe station, accredited personnel's tickets and OIAC/PIAC must be verified through the manual gate. After verification, you can enter the station's waiting area and have your QR code scanned to take the train.

At Yanqing and Taizicheng station, you can directly enter the waiting area and take the train through the manual gate after having your OIAC/PIAC checked.

Those whose identities cannot be verified will be denied access to the train.

You can check your ticket reservations on "My Bookings" page. Click the "QR code" button and use the code to check in and board the train.




# 3.1 User Guide for Accredited Personnel

Please log on the website and register by providing the information required.




Once registration is complete, you will be redirected to the login page.



# 3.1.2 Forgot Password


Click the "Forgot Password" button to reset your password.




# 3.1.3 Ticket Booking

The booking policy on the 12306 website is the same as that on the 12306 app. (See Section 2.2.3 for more details.)


a. You can search for available trains on the "Book a Winter Games Train Ticket" page according to your CLM status, together with the departure station, arrival station, and travel date.



b. You can proceed to select the seat by clicking the "Book" button on the right.





c. On the confirmation page, you can select your accompanying passengers, and click "Submit" to confirm.



# 3.1.4 Ticket Cancellation


After booking confirmation, you can check the ticket details in "My Bookings". You can cancel the ticket before train departure.






# 3.1.5 Edit Passengers

# 4. Print the Games Commemorative Tickets and E-Ticket Itinerary

During the Games service period, you can print the commemorative tickets or e-ticket itinerary at Qinghe, Yanqing, and Taizicheng stations.

- a. For closed-loop accredited personnel, please enter the order number and OIAC/PIAC number on the special ticket vending machine to print the commemorative tickets or e-ticket itinerary.
- b. For non-closed-loop accredited personnel, please provide the order number and the OIAC/PIAC number at the dedicated counter in stations to print the commemorative tickets or e-ticket itinerary.

# Part 2 Station Access and Train Boarding

# 1. Passenger Flow Lines

During the Games Time, to separate closed-loop personnel from non-closed-loop personnel, the stations and trains are subject to closed-end management, with designated stations, platforms, trains, carriages, and staff for closed-loop personnel. The closed-loop personnel may enter and leave the station through the dedicated passage.

# 1.1 Taizicheng Station

# 1.1.1 Dedicated Closed-Loop Flow Lines for Special Accredited Groups including Beijing 2022 Workers

Entrance Route: drop-off area – dedicated passage on the west side of Platform 1 - Platform 1 - waiting at the athlete service centre – boarding

Exit Route: Platform 1 - dedicated passage on the west side of Platform 1 - pick-up area - leave the station

# 1.1.2 Closed-Loop Flow Lines

Entrance Route: drop-off area - dedicated area on the east side of the underground transfer centre

- escalator on the east side of station square - station square - security check and temperature measurement at Entrance 2 - ground waiting room - check ticket at Gate 2 - entrance passage - Platform 1 - dedicated carriages

Exit Route: dedicated carriages - Platform 1 - entrance passage - ground waiting room - exit at Entrance 2 - station square - escalator on the east side of station square - dedicated area on the east side of the underground transfer centre - leave the station by bus

# **1.1.3 Flow Lines for Non-Closed-Loop Personnel and Ticketed Spectators** (Not open to ordinary passengers)

Entrance Route: drop-off area - Entrance 1 - underground waiting room - ticket check gate - escalator - entrance passage - platform

Exit Route: platform - exit passage - exit gate - underground transfer centre

# 1.2.1 Closed-Loop Personnel Flow Lines

Entrance Route: drop-off area - north passenger platform - security check and temperature

measurement - wait at the comprehensive service centre - ticket check gate – boarding gate (3-6B) - entrance escalator – platform (3-6) - carriage


Exit Route: platform (3-6) - platform escalator (3-6B upward) – ticket check gate (3-6B) - north passenger platform entrance - north passenger entrance – pick-up area

# 1.2.2 Non-Closed-Loop Personnel Flow Lines


Entrance Route: security check, temperature measurement, and ticket check - waiting area - ticket check gate (1-8A) (suburban trains use the same entrances as underground suburban trains) – platform (1-8) - boarding

Exit Route: platform - underground exit passage - exit

# 1.3.1 Closed-Loop Personnel Flow Lines

Entrance Route: drop-off area - east parking area - security check at waiting area for closed-loop personnel - wait at the comprehensive service centre - ticket check gate - east gate - Platform 1 - carriages for closed-loop personnel - boarding

Exit Route: carriages for closed-loop personnel - Platform 1 isolated area - east gate - dedicated passage - east parking area - pick-up area

# 1.3.2 Non-Closed-Loop Personnel Flow Lines

Entrance Route: entrance - security check - ticket check gate (at the west side of the waiting area)

- Platform 1 – designated non-closed-loop carriages

Exit Route: non-closed-loop carriages - non-closed-loop area of Platform 1 - escalator at the west side of the platform - exit passage - exit

# 3. Service Facilities



The coating of the Beijing Winter Olympics train "Auspicious Snow Ushers in Spring" features ice, snow and the colour blue on both ends. The white ribbons fly backward from the middle of the train head, as if dancing in the wind. The looming 24 snowflakes symbolise the 24<sup>th</sup> Winter Olympics, highlighting the Olympic theme.

# Service Button Panel

# Wireless Charger

The business-class seat can be adjusted 90-180 degrees and rotated 360 degrees. You can use the adjustment button at the inner side of the seat to adjust your seat. Behind the seat armrest is a reading lamp, and below a foldable tray table.

The first-class seat backrest angle can be adjusted with the adjustment button.



Baby Care Table

The accessible toilet is located at the 4<sup>th</sup> carriage and equipped with the baby care table, the emergency 'call button, toilet seat covers, etc.







Emergency Escape Window and Emergency Hammer

Do not move or press fire extinguishers, fire alarm buttons, emergency brake buttons and handles, and other safety equipment unless in case of emergency. In case of emergency escape and evacuation, you may use the emergency hammer to break the emergency escape window in the carriage after the train has stopped.

Washbasins and water dispensers are available in each carriage, serving hot and cold water for passengers.

# 4. Precautions

#### 4.1 Prohibited and Restricted Items

In accordance with the Regulations on the Administration of Railway Safety, other laws and

regulations issued by the State Council of the People's Republic of China, the following items are prohibited and restricted on board to ensure public security and passenger safety at railway stations and on trains:

- 4.1.1 Following types of guns, bullets and their main components are prohibited: pistol, rifle, submachine gun, machine gun, baton gun, other military guns, and their matched bullets; air gun, scattergun, sporting rifle, anesthesia gun, other civilian guns, and their matched bullets; prop gun, imitation gun, starter pistols, steel ball gun, fire extinguishers and other types of guns; samples and replicas of above items.
- 4.1.2 Following explosive articles are prohibited: bomb, illuminating projectile, napalm bomb, smoke bomb, signal shell, tear shell, gas bomb, grenade, hand grenade, and ammunitions; explosive, detonator, blasting fuse, detonating fuse, blasting agent, igniter, and other explosive equipment; shell, firework, firecracker, cherry bomb, pulling firecracker, igniting material for starting gun and other kinds of fireworks; black powder, smoke powder, fuse, and other firework products; samples and replicas of above items.
- 4.1.3 Following weapons are prohibited: dagger, triangular files (including those for mechanical processing purpose), flick knife with a self-locking device, backsword, double-edged knife, and other controlled knives; kitchen knife, table-knife, slaughter knife, axe, and other edged or blunt tools which may threaten passengers' safety; police stick, tear gas weapon, defibrillator, stun gun, nail gun, defence equipment, bow, crossbow, etc.
- 4.1.4 Flammable and explosive materials are prohibited: hydrogen, methane, hexane, butane, natural gas, ethylene, propylene, ethyne (soluble), carbonic oxide, liquefied petroleum gas, freon, oxygen (except for medical oxygen in bags), water gas, and other compressed or liquefied gas; gasoline, kerosene, diesel, benzene, ethyl alcohol (alcohol), acetone, diethyl ether, oil varnish, solvent, retinol, flammable liquid and other materials containing flammable solvent; red phosphorus, flash powder, solid alcohol, celluloid, blowing agent H and other flammable solids; yellow phosphorus, white phosphorus, nitrocellulose (including film), oil paper and its products as well as other self-ignite articles; potassium, sodium, lithium, calcium carbide, magnesium aluminium powder which may burn in moisture circumstances; potassium permanganate, potassium chlorate, sodium peroxide, potassium peroxide, lead peroxide, peracetic acid, hydrogen peroxide, and other oxidising agent or organic peroxides.
- 4.1.5 Toxic, corrosive, radioactive or infectious articles are prohibited: cyanide, arsenic, selenium

powder, phenol, and other highly toxic chemicals or pesticide like tetramine; sulfuric acid, hydrochloric acid, nitric acid, sodium hydroxide, potassium hydroxide, battery containing potassium hydroxide, acid or alkali, mercury, and other corrosive articles; radioisotope and other radioactive substances; hepatitis B virus, anthrax bacillus, tuberculosis bacillus, AIDS virus, and other infectious pathogens; other dangerous articles that cannot be identified.

- 4.1.6 Following articles that may harm train operation security or public health safety are prohibited: magnetic solid materials which may cause signal interference, articles with strong pungent or stink smell, live animals (except for guide dogs), items that may damage or contaminate stations, train service facilities, or spare parts, etc.
- 4.1.7 Following items are allowed to carry in reasonable quantities or capacities: nail enamel, delusterant or hair dye no more than 20 millilitres; cold perm, mousse, hair gel, insecticide, air freshener, and other self-excited pressure vessels no more than 120 millilitres; two boxes of safety matches and two ordinary lighters at most.
- 4.1.8 Other prohibited and restricted articles carried by passengers shall be handled in accordance with laws, administrative regulations, and rules issued by the People's Republic of China.
- 4.1.9 Illegal carrying of the above items shall be handled in accordance with laws and regulations of the People's Republic of China.

#### 4.2 Epidemic Prevention and Control

For the safety and health of all Games participants and local residents, please strictly follow *The Playbook* (V2) while at the railway station and on the train, including keeping your wear on, having your body temperature taken, and following the instructions of staff in case of emergency.
