Expected Activities/Results	To reward projects that show resilience, giving examples of how to overcome obstacles to participation	To reward projects that show tolerance, giving positive examples of different people groups and working together or emphasize the benefits of understanding each other	To reward projects that show inspiration, giving positive examples of empowerment and role models from groups with fewer opportunities that step up and lead change
