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1. EYOF 2023 FRIULI VENEZIA GIULIA

Friuli Venezia Giulia, with its Alps and Dolomites, millenary forests, winter sports facilities and a long tradition in organising sports events and tourist hospitality, will host the XVI edition of the EYOF - EUROPEAN YOUTH OLYMPIC FESTIVAL aimed at affirming the values of sport as a tool for borderless individual and collective growth.

Friuli Venezia Giulia, Austria and Slovenia will stage a great no boundaries European Event in winter sports as: Alpine Skiing, Biathlon, Cross Country, Curling, Figure Skating, Freestyle Skiing, Ski Cross, Ice Hockey, Short Track, Ski Jumping, Ski Mountaineering, Nordic Combined and Snowboard (alpine – cross – freestyle) will be held in 12 venues.







2. EYOF2023_THE EVENT

From the 21st to the 28th of January 2023 athletes aged 14 to 18 years, from 47 confirmed European countries, will engage in 100 scheduled competitions.

For the first time ever in a European Youth Olympic Festival, Freestyle Skiing and Ski Mountaineering will debut at the EYOF2023.

4. SPORT & VENUES

The EYOF 2023 sport program consist of 14 events, including snow Sports: alpine skiing, biathlon, cross-country skiing, nordic combined, ski jumping, snowboard (Alpine & Cross / slopestyle & big air), freestyle skiing (slopestyle & big air / ski Cross), and ski mountaineering; and ice sports: curling, figure skating, ice hockey and short track. Three events will debut for the first time ever at EYOF2023: Freeski slopestyle & Big Air, Ski Cross and Ski Mountaineering.

The 100 competitions scheduled in EYOF2023 will be held in 12 Sport Venues, focused in 3 geographical areas – Cluster Villages: **Carnia | Tarvisio | Piancavallo**, with an estimated number of 2000 athletes and officials from about 47 European Nations.

The Cluster of Carnia includes the venues: Sappada – Forni Avoltri – Ravascletto / Zoncolan – Forni di Sopra.

The Cluster of Tarvisio includes the nearby Austrian and Slovenian venues of **Spittal** and **Planica**; **Tarvisio** – **Pontebba** – **Udine** – **Sella Nevea**.

The Cluster of Piancavallo comprises Claut and Piancavallo as well.

The NOC President and Secretary General will be accredited as VIPs and will not fall under the quota of NOC Officials (unless they have an operational role within the official NOC delegation and are required to reside in the Athletes' Village). In this case, they will be included in the GO contingent.

Team Official (Ao) are entitled to enter all sports facilities - training competition areas.

The figure skating judges are provided and paid by the NOCs - a system of cost sharing between all NOCs participating in figure skating is applied - the judges pay the same participation fee as an NOC delegation member.

A NOC may apply for the specific number of **working passes** if it registers at least one athlete per only snow sports concerned. WP holders are entitled to use the EYOF shuttle system and can enter the respective sport venue - team area. The NOCs are also financially responsible for the international travel, accommodation and stay of the WP holders. Working passes cost is €150 per person per day. Working passes holders will be accommodated in the same Hotel as their National Teams.



5. CONDITION OF PARTICIPATION - QUALIFICATION

(As per the EYOF Charter)

Participation in the European Youth Olympic Festival is open to all European young athletes nominated by their National Olympic Committee, subject to the current EYOF Charter and EOC regulations on age categories and quotas published for each EYOF edition. The criteria for the qualification of athletes/teams are in the remit of the respective NOCs with the exception of team sports where the qualification systems/criteria are set up by the respective IF/EFs.

Any competitor in the EYOF must be a national or citizen of the country or territory of the NOC that is entering him/her or have the right of being a national or citizen of such country when the competitor reaches the legal age of majority. In any case, the NOC must, on the request of the Organising Committee (OC) or the EOC, duly approve the nationality, citizenship or right to obtain the one or the other by the competitor.

An NOC that wishes to enter an athlete who does not meet these criteria, must submit a written and detailed request to the EYOF COCOM not later than four months before the date of the Opening Ceremony. The EYOF COCOM will make a recommendation to the EOC Executive Committee, which will at its sole discretion decide whether the request can be accepted or not.



6. STAY AT EYOF2023

All EYOF2023 athletes shall remain at the European Youth Olympic Festival for the duration of the Festival at least from the day of the Opening Ceremony (21stJanuary) until the day of the Closing Ceremony (28th January 2023). Athletes are encouraged to attend as many sport competitions as possible as spectators and take part in EYOF2023 side events.

- Official day of arrival: 20th January 2023
- Official day of departure: 29th January 2023





7. EVENTS AND VENUES PROGRAMME

The Opening Ceremony will be held on 21st January in Trieste, while the Closing Ceremony is scheduled for 28th January 2023 in Udine.

7.2 VICTORY CEREMONIES

Victory Ceremonies will consist of a Flower/Mascot Ceremony at Competition sites, followed by a Medal Ceremony at the relative Medal Plaza along with the raising of flags and playing of the national anthem of the winner.

In some cases, a complete Victory Ceremony will be held at the venue awarding both Flower/Mascot and Victory Ceremonies. This will be the case for Ice Sports.

In compliance to Rule 50 of the Olympic Charter, athletes must wear their appropriate NOC team uniform (competition or ceremony, depending on the type of Victory Ceremony), and may not carry nor wear any additional flags, banners or other merchandise on the podium.

FLOWER CEREMONIES

Flower Ceremonies will be held at the relative Sport Venue and completed after the competition has finished.

Location: at the Sport Venue staging area.

Program: Athletes will be presented in the following order: third, second, first place. Athletes will wear the correct uniform as described in the EOC guidelines for Athletes' uniform at Victory Ceremonies and in line with Rule 50.

MEDAL CEREMONIES

The Victory ceremonies will be held in different Medal Plazas.

Date/ Hours: according to the Sport program.

Location: see the schedule below

Program: During the Victory Ceremony, athletes from the 1st to 3rd places will be announced in reverse order and will receive their medals. The national Flags of the medallists' NOCs will be raised as the national anthem of the gold medallist is played.

8.GENERAL INFORMATION

	TRIESTE and VENICE (Marco Polo Airport) International Airports are the official Points of Entry for the EYOF2023.
	EYOF2023 will provide free bus transport between Trieste/Venice International Airports and the Accommodation clusters for arrivals and departures.
ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE BY AIR	Welcome Desk with volunteers will be located in the airports arrival area to assist NOCs with transfer to the Accommodation Clusters. Operating hours of the Welcome Desk will be in accordance with the arrival information submitted by NOCs in ASEP.
	NOC delegations will be met in the arrival hall and will be escorted to EYOF2023 shuttle buses with their luggage and sport equipment for transfer to the Accommodation clusters.
	For departures, pick-up times from the Accommodation Clusters to the airport will be confirmed 2 days before departures at the Transport Desk in hotel.
ARRIVAL BY ROAD IN A PRIVATE VEHICLE	If arriving by road, NOCs must inform EYOF2023 about date and approximate time of arrival, number and types of vehicles and license plate numbers. EYOF will make advance arrangements for NOCs arriving and parking in their respective hotels.
	For the location of the hotel please refer to the interactive maps on the website
	EYOF2023 will provide a special transport system for all accredited people free of charge. The transport service will be organised to cover requirements at all levels: arrival/departure, competitions, technical meetings, etc.
TRANSPORT SYSTEMS	A shuttle service will be available on a daily basis and at pre-fixed times for transport from the hotels to the training areas and competition venues. The timetable will be defined on the basis of the programmes and will be available in all the official hotels.
SYSTEMS	The TA shuttle will provide transport for athletes and team officials between the Hotels in each Cluster and each sport venue. This applies also for Ice Hockey teams which travel by plane.
	Also, other accredited participants can use this service among other bus service for media staff, judges, technical delegates and volunteers.
	Inter Cluster Transfer is available on request and in limited number of vehicles by prior reservation 24 hours in advance for chefs de mission; chef de mission deputies; medical staff.

SPORT EQUIPMENT TRANSPORT	Sports equipment, with the exception of weapons and ammunition for Biathlon, must be stored in wax cabins/boxes at the relative sport venue or in a dedicate area at the accommodation facilities where the delegations are staying and must be brought to the competition venues. Ice Hockey teams will travel in a dedicated bus directly from the airport to the venue where they can unload their equipment and material and put it in the team dressing rooms. If team members arrive separately, they can bring their equipment to the venue when arriving for their first training session. Should team members arrive in their own vehicles, they can bring their equipment with them to the venue when coming to the first training session. Personal sports equipment storage and waxing facilities are provided at the locations as indicated in the Chapter Sport Information
PARKING AT THE COMPETITION VENUES	VAPPs (Vehicle Access and/or Parking Permits) will be required for vehicle access at all competition venues. VAPPs will be available to NOCs in accordance with the parking capacity in each venue and information about number of cars provided by NOCs. VAPPs will allow access to the accredited parking areas. VAPPs will be handed over to Chefs de Mission at the Introductory Meeting. VAPPs must be clearly displayed inside the front window screen of the vehicle upon entry to the parking area and at all times while the vehicle is parked. Being titular (assigned by name) VAPPs can be moved from one car to the other provided that the driver is an accredited person Parking areas will be monitored by EYOF2023 staff.
NOC INFORMATION POINTS (NIP)	Please note that VAPPs will not be replaced if damaged or lost. During the Festival, there will be NOC Information Points located in the halls of the hotels, offering NOCs information and services. MEDICAL AND ANTI DOPING INFORMATION	At the EYOF2023 doping tests will be taken by the well qualified doping controllers of the International Anti-Doping Agency (ITA) commissioned by the EOC for the implementation of the anti-doping programme at winter EYOFs.

The number of tests for the EYOF2023 are 75 about 10 of which should contain blood also and will be analysed by the laboratory accredited by the International Testing Agency.

The following key points in the doping control procedure are to be highlighted:

- The notification process will be conducted without any advance notice. It is recommended that notification of the athlete who is a minor is conducted in the presence of an adult/guardian.
- If the athlete would like to have a representative present during the notification and/or throughout the sample collection procedure, the chaperone must escort the athlete to locate a representative who can accompany him/her at notification and/or throughout the sample collection procedure. In line with the international regulations and in order to protect the rights of minors, an adult chaperone from the national team of each under-age athlete has to be present.
- The doping controls will be carried out in and out-of-competition with no advance notice. Upon notification of a doping control, the athlete will be required to present himself/herself immediately at the DCS, unless the Doping-control officer (DCO) gives the athlete permission to postpone the doping control for the reasons set out in the International Standard for Testing and Investigations (ISTI).
- All doping controls will be conducted in separate processing rooms set up exclusively for doping control purposes providing the required privacy and confidentiality for athletes as well as security for the sample collection procedures. DCS will comply with all provisions set out in the EOC Anti-Doping rules, the World Anti-Doping Code and its accompanying International Standards. The organisers will ensure the optimal temperature of the rooms, a sufficient number of sealed drinks and snacks.

TUE procedure will be performed according to the WADA International Standard for Therapeutic Use Exemption applicable for EYOF. Please kindly note that all updated information related to the TUE process can be found on https://ita.sport/tue-winter-EYOF-2023.

Upon entering Italy, Border Service will check the documents required to enter, or for the introduction of weapons and ammunition in Italy.

Biathlon rifle and ammunition List – Invitation Letter

In order to facilitate the arrival and departure at customs regarding rifle and ammunition, please find on Extranet the document "Biathlon rifle and ammunition List – Invitation Letter" containing fields to enter the travel data, accommodation, data of the athletes, weapons and ammunition which must be completed in all its parts and returned to the nocservices@eyof2023.it by 21st December 2022. The OC will provide indication of the allotment of the room in due time to fill the document (end of November).

After filling in the form, the validated document will be returned to all delegations. They are required to carry with to cross the Italian border (whether they arrive by car or by plane).

Arrival by air: On arrival at the international airport of Trieste/Venice the sports equipment for Biathlon (rifles and ammunition) will be collected by the delegation leader who will have with him the authorisation to transport the rifles and ammunition. The rifles and ammunition must be stowed in the bus with which the delegation leader will be transported directly to the Biathlon Centre in Forni Avoltri. Rifles and ammunition will be deposited in the armoury specially prepared by EYOF2023 by the person in charge, who will receive a special receipt.

Rifles and ammunition have to be packed into bags, boxes or chests, specifically provided for this purpose, IN SUCH A WAY THAT THEY CANNOT BE USED IMMEDIATELY.

In order to prevent any damage during storing they must be tagged accordingly in order to be able to claim the correct rifle and ammunition in the competition venue.

It is mandatory that rifles and ammunitions will be transported exclusively from the airport of arrival, or from the customs point of entry into Italy, to the Biathlon Centre armoury where they will remain for the entire period of the competitions. No overnight storage in the accommodation or car is allowed.

Competition Regulation

World Curling Federation (WCF) rules apply, unless otherwise indicated below or explained at the Team Meeting Sunday, 13.30h

The 14 teams have been divided into two groups (A & B) and each group will play a round robin series. At the end of the round robins there will be a ranking established for places 1 and 2 in each group. The team ranked 1st in each Group will play the second ranked team from the other Group in the semi-finals. The winners of the semi-finals advance to the Gold medal game. Losers of the semi-finals play in the Bronze medal game.

All games will be eight (8) ends, with extra end(s) to break tied games.

There will be a five (5) minute practice for each team before each round robin game. The practice starts 15 minutes before the scheduled game time. The team with the first practice during the round robin will be the team with dark-colored stones.

At the conclusion of the team's pre-game practice, two players each deliver a stone to the tee at the home end; the first stone with a clockwise rotation, and the second stone with a counterclockwise rotation. The distances are combined to determine the Last Stone Draw (LSD) for that game. The team with the lesser LSD distance has the choice of delivering first or second stone in the first end. If the LSD totals for both teams are the same, the individual LSD stones are compared and the best non-equal LSD has the choice of delivering first or second stone in the first end. When both teams have the exact same individual LSD stone distances, a coin toss will be used to determine that choice.

First named teams in each draw play the stones with the dark-colored handles, and wear dark-colored upper playing garments. Second named teams in each draw play the stones with the light-colored handles, and wear light-colored upper playing garments.

The Chief Umpire will determine the schedule and ice for all post round robin games as soon as the opponents have been determined.

Equipment control

The teams must bring their own jerseys. Two sets with different colours (bright and dark). Home teams have the right to choose the jersey colour and bench allocation. The EOC EYOF Rules on advertising on clothes applies.

The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the <u>ISU Constitution and General Regulation 2021.</u>

The Anti-Doping tests will be conducted by the International Anti-Doping Agency (ITA) in accordance with the World Anti-doping Agency's Code and International Standard for Testing. Based on and the European Olympic Committees.

To conduct the doping tests of Figure Skating, there will be doping control room at the Ice Arena "Claudio Vuerich".

Conditions of Participation

Participation in the Competition of EYOF 2023 is open to all Competitors who belong to a NOC and be an ISU Member in accordance with Rule 130, paragraph 2 and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and Communication No. 2030 (or any updated of this Communication). In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2030 (or any update of this Communication), all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, <u>must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate</u>.

Please note that for organizational reasons the ISU Clearance Certificate must be presented via NOC <u>before</u> receiving the accreditation for verification (<u>NOT at the accreditation</u>). Without the ISU Clearance Certificate, competitors cannot receive the accreditation.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation via the NOC before the 21st December 2022.

Music

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulation & Technical Rules Single & Pair skating and Ice Dance 2022, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality in a format and means announced in the announcement of the competition in accordance with Rule 112;
- Each submission shall be labelled with the competitor's name, the Nation, competition event and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration;
- Each program (Short Program/Free Program) must be recorded on a separate track;
- Competitors must provide an own back-up drive (USB stick) for each program in a format and means as per the announcement of the competition in accordance with Rule 112 (WAV or MP3 files)

Please note that CDs will NOT be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

A simple music form for the programs of each competitor indicating the name and the duration of the music must be sent via NOC no later than the 21st December 2022). If music information is not complete or/and the music is not provided accreditation will not be given.

Judges Selection Procedure

Each Panel of Judges will consist of a minimum of 5 Judges and a maximum of 7 Judges. Each participating NOC is requested to nominate one judge with at least the qualification "International judge", one judge can be nominated by NOCs: for Girls' competition (if the NOC has a skater in this discipline), for Boys' competition (if the NOC has a skater in this discipline) or for both competition (if the NOC has a skater in both disciplines).

Composition of Judges Panel

During the Chef de Mission Seminar 19-22 September 2022, seven judges have been drawn for each Panel.

The seating order will be drawn 45 minutes prior to each segment of the category. The Referees and the Technical Panels (technical specialists and controllers), as well as Data and Replay Operators, have been appointed by the OC and FISG.

The start interval between two competitors is approximately 45-50 seconds. The green starting signal indicates to competitors that the hill is clear, and that they must start within the next 10 seconds (start control time). A competitor who does not leave the starting gate within the 10 second period will be disqualified. The starting order for the training, trial and first competition rounds is drawn randomly. In the final round, competitors start in reverse order of the results from the first round.

TEAM EVENTS

In the team competition there are four groups for both the trial round and the two competition rounds. One competitor from each team is entered into each of the groups.



- Qualification: 2 runs, best run counts. 2 heats girls, and 2 heats boys. To finals: Top 4 girls, and Top 5 boys from each heat.
- Finals: 3 runs, best run count.

SNOWBOARD BIG AIR FORMAT

The big air competition is a judged sport. The competitors perform tricks on the BA jump by taking off from a kicker and aiming to attain sizable airtime, well executed tricks all while securing a clean solid landing. The BA kicker will be the exact same one as the first kicker from the Slopestyle course.

- Qualification: 2 runs, best runs counts. 2 heats girls, and 2 heats boys. To finals: Top 4 girls, and Top 5 boys from each heat.
- Finals: 3 runs. They will be ranked according to their two best (different) jumps of three.
- Alternate formats: In the unlikely case that the event must be run faster (e.g. due to weather conditions or force majeure), alternate formats could be used (for example there will be no Qualification, the Final could be reduced to two jumps, Qualification with two heats and double-up judging).
