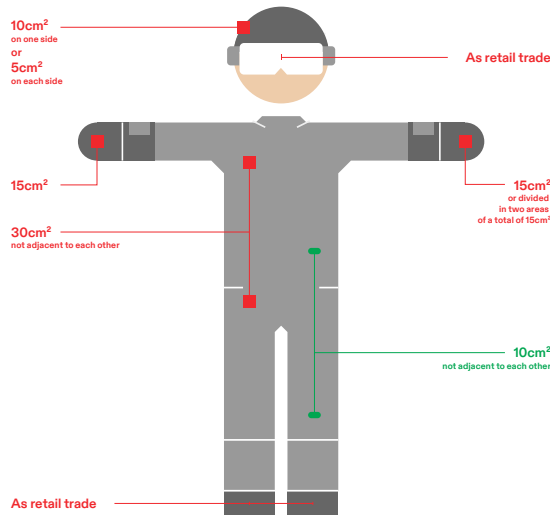
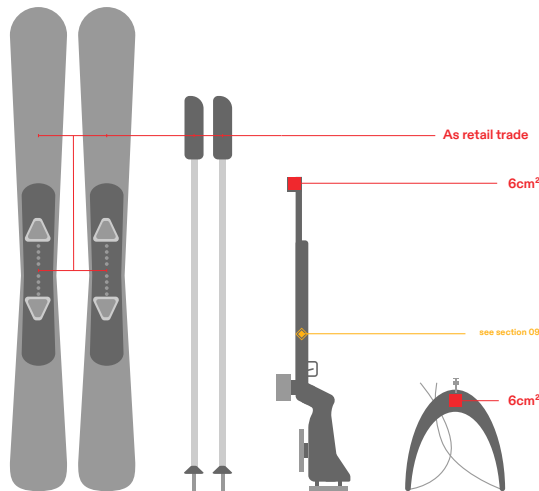

All General Principles apply unless expressly mentioned otherwise hereafter (in particular in relation to size, frequency or location). Please refer to the “Identifications on NOC Team Apparel Practical Guidelines”, and General Guidelines (released Summer 2023) to obtain the general principles of Authorised Identifications on NOC uniforms at the Olympic Games. This section provides visual illustrations regarding the placement and size of Sport Specific Implementation for any items.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

Section 14 of General Guidelines apply

No additional obligatory submission process required by the IF, section 14 of the General Guidelines applies.

Pre-Competition

Before the Winter Youth Olympic Games the RD/ TD, and IBU Material Referee will conduct a preliminary inspection of equipment to confirm that the materials, equipment and clothing to be used by teams are permitted by the rules.

The check will normally be done at least two days before the first competition.

The preliminary examination does not relieve competitors of the obligation to pass equipment inspection at the start and finish.

01 ATHLETE

Identification of the Manufacturer

Clothing

- Competition clothing/ Warm-up & Training suits**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm².
- One-piece bodysuit**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum sizes noted above; however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.
- Two-piece body suit**
 One *Identification of the manufacturer* per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm².
- Collars and roll necks**
 If a roll neck or polo shirt is worn, no identification of the manufacturer may appear on the collar or on the neck. Only one *Identification of the Manufacturer* will be allowed; it may be situated on the chest, with a maximum size of 30cm².
- Socks / Gloves**
 Please refer to general principles.
- Headgear/Headband**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per Item, with a maximum size of 10cm² or two *Identifications of the Manufacturer* per accessory item will be

permitted, with a maximum size of 5cm² each and placed above each ear.

- Eyewear**

May carry the *Manufacturer Identification* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

Sport Equipment

- Warm up/Race Gloves**

One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 15cm² or divided in two areas of a total of 15cm².

Accessories

- Bag**

One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per bag will be permitted, covering no more than 10% of the surface, to a maximum size of 60cm².

- Neck warmer**

One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 15cm².

- Shoes / Footwear**

All footwear items may carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 month before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

Product Technology Identification

Clothing

- Competition clothing/Warm-up & Training suits**
 One additional *Product Technology Identification* will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm².
- One-piece bodysuit**
 One *Product Technology Identification* [■] shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum sizes noted above; however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

Additional IF Specifications

Section 05

Third Party Identifications (Athletes names)

Athletes may display their own names on their warm-up, kiss and cry area clothing and off the ice clothing and equipment.

02 EQUIPMENT

Identification of the Manufacturer

- Skis / Bindings / Poles**
 May carry the *Manufacturer Identification* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games.
 - Rifle (including rifle stock)**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 6cm² at the front end of the rifle barrel.
 - Rifle carrying harness**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 6cm² underneath the fixation of the carrying harness system.
 - Rifle shooting sling**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 6cm².
 - Rifle case / Rifle bag**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted, covering no more than a maximum total dimension of 50cm to 15cm.
 - Arm loop**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per accessory item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 15cm².
- As stated in the General Principles, where the *Identification of the Manufacturer* is not a Sports Brand (Biathlon rifle manufacturers included), such identification shall not be permitted.
- Telescope**
 Two *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted per side, to a maximum area of 50cm².
 - Telescope stand**
 May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* with a maximum size of 15cm² per leg.
 - Telescope carrying strap**
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* will be permitted on carrying straps, to a maximum size of 30cm².
