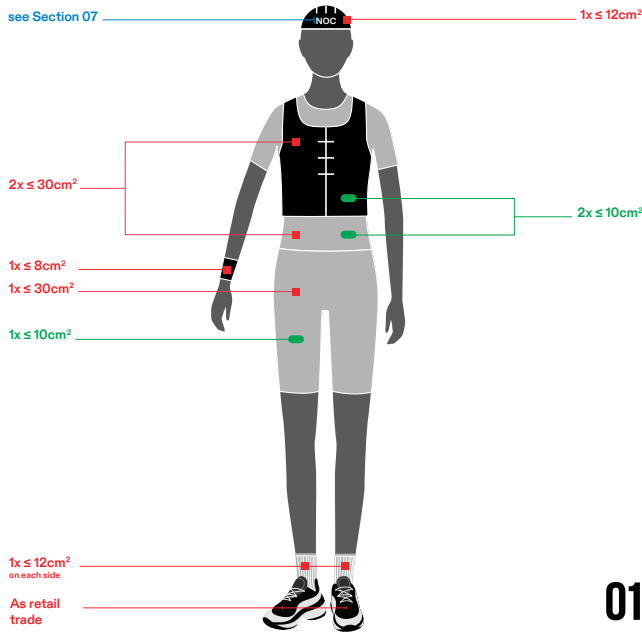

SUBMISSION PROCESS

The IOC has set up a new tool for items to be reviewed and offer assistance. The new Uniform Submission tool is now live on [RELAY](#), where uniforms can be submitted to the IOC for review.

If you are an NOC who does not have access to RELAY and needs access to submit the uniforms, please email nocnet@olympic.org

As in previous Games, while the process is not mandatory, it is highly encouraged in order to minimise any possible Games-time issues. Once a submission has been made through the online tool, NOCs and IFs will be notified of the “reviewed” or “non-compliant” status of their submitted items.

A mandatory pre-competition verification process by ICF officials for competition clothing and equipment will take place during boat control, as per ICF regulations for competition.

01 ATHLETE FRONT CANOE, KAYAK AND KAYAK CROSS EVENTS

Identification of the Manufacturer

Clothing

- **T-shirt/Singlet | Shorts/Pants | Life jacket | Tracksuit/Warm-up jacket | Spray skirt**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm².
- **One-piece body suit | Spray skirt**
Where one-piece body suits are used in competition, one *Identification of the Manufacturer* shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum size noted above, however these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

Sport Equipment

- **Helmet**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 12cm².

Accessories

- **Armband**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 8cm².

- **Gloves**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 12cm².
- **Eyewear**
May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 months or more prior to the Games, with the Identifications permitted on the lenses so long as such identifications are tone-on-tone, engraved into the lens, and is not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC.
- **Towel**
No *Identification of the Manufacturer* will be permitted.
- **Bag | Paddle Bag**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted, not greater than 10% of the surface area of the item, to a maximum size of 60cm².

Shoes/Footwear

Shoes
All footwear items may carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 months or more prior to the Games.

Product Technology Identification

Clothing

- **T-shirt/Singlet | Shorts/Pants | Life jacket | Tracksuit/Warm-up jacket | Spray skirt**
One additional *Product Technology Identification* [●] will be permitted per clothing, to a maximum size of 10cm².
- **One-piece body suit | Spray skirt**
Where one-piece body suits are used in competition, one *Product Technology Identification* shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum size noted above, however these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

NOC Emblems and National Identity

The NOC code may appear on the helmet and should be visible on both sides of the boat. NOC codes will be provided by the OCOG at time of competition.

For clothing, no IF specific limitations with regard to National Identifications apply.

02 SLALOM BOAT AND KAYAK CROSS BOAT

Identification of the Manufacturer

Sport Equipment

- **Boats**
Two *Identifications of the Manufacturer* [■] are permitted, one on each side of the shell of the boat, up to 60cm² for each identification.
- **Paddle**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 60cm².

Third Party Identifications (athlete names)

The athletes surname and initials will be visible on both sides of the boat. These will be provided by the OCOG at time of competition.

NOC Emblems and National Identity

The NOC code may appear on the helmet and should be visible on both sides of the boat. NOC codes will be provided by the OCOG at time of competition.

Flags, emblems and NOC codes can be displayed on paddle blades. Olympic rings may appear on the shaft of the paddle (optional) and the NOC code may be displayed on the helmet.

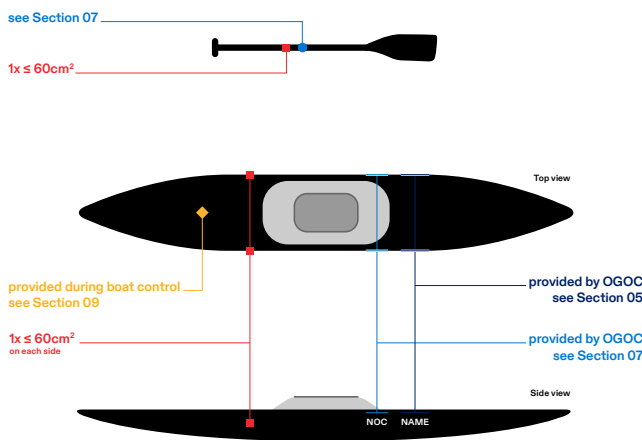

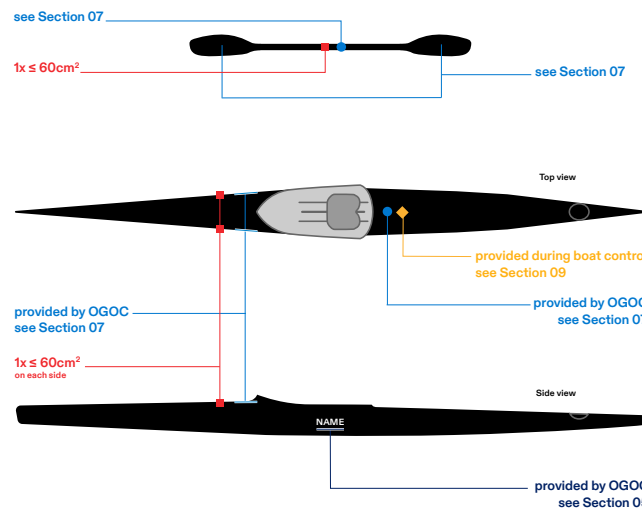
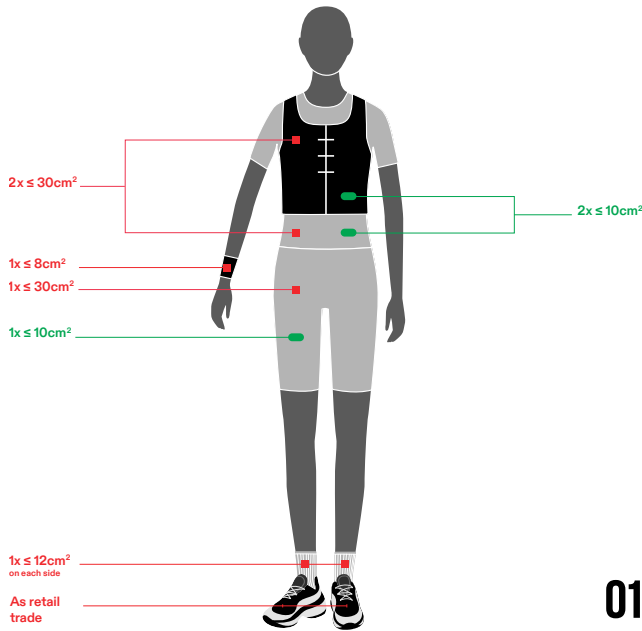
A homologation mark/sticker [◆] on Canoe equipment will be provided by ICF officials at the time of boat control, as per ICF regulations for competition.

This section provides visual illustrations regarding the placement and size of Sport Specific Implementation for any items.

01 ATHLETE FRONT CANOE SPRINT

Identification of the Manufacturer

Clothing

- **T-shirt/Singlet | Shorts/Pants | Tracksuit/Warm-up jacket | Spray skirt**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm².
- **One-piece body suit | Spray skirt**
Where one-piece body suits are used in competition, one *Identification of the Manufacturer* shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum size noted above, however these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

Accessories

- **Armband**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 8cm².
- **Gloves**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 12cm².
- **Eyewear**
May carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 months or more prior to the Games, with the Identifications permitted on the lenses so long as such identifications are tone-on-tone, engraved into the lens, and is not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC.
- **Towel**
No *Identification of the Manufacturer* will be permitted.
- **Bag | Paddle bag**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted, not greater than 10% of the surface area of the item, to a maximum size of 60cm².
- **Hat | Bandana**
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item will be permitted, not greater than 10% of the surface area of the item, to a maximum size of 60cm².

Shoes/Footwear

Shoes

All footwear items may carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 months or more prior to the Games.

Product Technology Identification

Clothing

- **T-shirt/Singlet | Shorts/Pants | Tracksuit/Warm-up jacket Spray skirt**
One additional *Product Technology Identification* [■] will be permitted per clothing, to a maximum size of 10cm².
- **One-piece body suit | Spray skirt**
Where one-piece body suits are used in competition, one *Product Technology Identification* shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum size noted above, however these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

02 SPRINT BOAT

Identification of the Manufacturer

Sport Equipment

- **Boats**
Two *Identifications of the Manufacturer* [■] are permitted, one on each side of the shell of the boat, up to 60cm² for each identification.

Size of the Manufacture stickers according to the different Sprint Olympic boats:

- K1 — 5,2m x 0,41m
- C1 — 5,2m x 0,36m
- K2 — 6,5m x 0,41m
- C2 — 6,5m x 0,44m
- K4 — 11m x 0,45m

- **Paddle**

One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■] per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 60 cm², and should be displayed on the middle of the paddle shaft.

Section 05

Third Party Identifications (athlete names)

The athletes surname and initials will be visible on both sides of the boat. These will be provided by the OCOG at time of competition.

Section 07

NOC Emblems and National Identity

The NOC code may appear and should be visible on both sides of the boat. NOC codes will be provided by the OCOG at time of competition.

Flags, emblems and NOC codes can be displayed on paddle blades. Olympic rings may appear on the shaft of the paddle (optional).

One country flag/sticker can be displayed on top of the boat deck's with 20cm x 10cm and must be placed behind the last athlete's position. These stickers will be provided by the OCOG at the boat control one day before of the competitions starts.

Homologation Marks

A homologation mark/sticker [◆] on Canoe Sprint equipment will be provided by ICF officials at the boat control, as per ICF regulations. This must be placed on the top deck of the boat behind of the last athlete's position.
