

# ISSF — SHOOTING







All General Principles apply unless expressly mentioned otherwise hereafter (in particular in relation to size, frequency or location). Please refer to the "Identifications on NOC Team Apparel Practical Guidelines", and General Guidelines (released Summer 2023) to obtain the general principles of Authorised Identifications on NOC uniforms at the Olympic Games. This section provides visual illustrations regarding the placement and size of Sport Specific Implementation for any items.

# SUBMISSION PROCESS

The IOC has set up a new tool for items to be reviewed and offer assistance. The new Uniform Submission tool is now live on **BELAY**, where uniforms can be submitted to the IOC for review.

If you are an NOC who does not have access to RELAY and needs access to submit the uniforms, please email nocnet@olympic.org

As in previous Games, while the process is not mandatory for this sport, it is still highly encouraged to submit uniform for review to minimise any possible Games-time issues. Once a submission has ben made through the IOC's online submission tool, NOCs will be notified of the "reviewed" or "non-

compliant" status of their submitted items.

All shooting equipment and clothing used in competition must comply with ISSF General Technical Rules (Rifle, Rule 7.4 and 7.5; Pistol, Rule 8.4, 8.5 and 8.6; Shotgun, Rule 9.4). Precompetition testing is optional for athletes, but all shooting equipment and clothing is subject to Jury checks during the competition and to random post-competition testing.

# **01 ATHLETE FRONT**

# Identification of the Manufacturer

#### Clothing

 Rifle Jacket | Rifle Trousers | Shotgun vest | Shirt | Skirt | Sweat top | Sweat pants | Underwear | Trousers/Shorts

One Identification of the Manufacturer [ item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>.

### Sport Equipment

 Rifle/Pistol/Shotgun | Gun case | Equipment bag/ container | Rifle sling | Shooting glove | Kneeling roll | Spotting | Telescope | Telescope stand | Rifle rest/stand

One Identification of the Manufacturer [ on each item, not greater than 10% of the surface area of the item, with a maximum size of 60cm<sup>2</sup>.

Headgear/Visors | Shooting glasses | Side/front blinders | Ear protection

One Identification of the Manufacturer [ is permitted on each item to a maximum size of 6cm<sup>2</sup>. Alternatively, two Identifications of the Manufacturer with a maximum size of 4cm<sup>2</sup> are permitted, if one is placed on each arm/side.

### Accessories

- Gloves One Identification of the Manufacturer is permitted, to a maximum size of 8cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Belt

One Identification of the Manufacturer is permitted, to a maximum size of 6cm<sup>2</sup>.

- Socks One Identification of the Manufacturer is permitted, to a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Bag

One Identification of the Manufacturer per item will be permitted, not greater than 10% of the surface area of the item, to a maximum size of 60cm<sup>2</sup>.

 Towel No Identification of the Manufacturer will be permitted.

# Shoes/Footwear

#### Shoes

All footwear items may carry the Identification of the Manufacturer as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 months or more prior to the Games.

# Clothing

Rifle Jacket | Rifle Trousers | Shotgun vest | Shirt | Skirt | Sweat top | Sweat pants | Underwear | Trousers/Shorts One additional Product Technology Identification [ - ] will be permitted per clothing item to a maximum size of 10 cm<sup>2</sup>

# NOC Emblem and National Identity

Additional IF Specifications

#### Section 05

#### Third Party Identifications (athlete names)

The athlete's family name and first initial must be displayed on the back of shooting vests or outer garments worn by shotgun athletes.

The athlete's family name and/or given name may be displayed on the shirts, shooting jackets and shooting trousers worn by rifle and pistol athletes.

#### Section 07

#### NOC Emblems and National Identity

The NOC code must be displayed on the back of shooting vests or outer garments worn by shotgun athletes. National flags or NOC emblems [) may be placed on:

- The front of headgear (caps or visors).
- · Ear muffs (ear protection).
- · The back of shotgun vests next to the NOC code.

• On the shoulders of shooting jackets that are turned away from the targets or shirts that are worn by rifle or pistol athletes.

All clothing worn on the field of play must comply with the "ISSF Dress Code" (Rule 6.20 of the ISSF General Technical Rules). Sporting colours should be national uniform colours.

## **Homologation Marks**

Additional IF Specifications

#### Section 09 Homologation Marks

All rifle shooting jackets and trousers must have a seal [ + ] with a unique serial number issued by ISSF Equipment Control and registered in the ISSF database. Government regulations also require firearms to bear identifications stamped in the metal that bear the manufacturer's name, firearm model and calibre.

# NOC Emblem and National Identity

#### Section 05

Third Party Identifications (athlete names)

The athlete's family name and first initial must be displayed on the back of shooting vests or outer garments worn by shotgun athletes.

The athlete's family name and/or given name may be displayed on the shirts, shooting jackets and shooting trousers worn by rifle and pistol athletes.

#### Section 07

NOC Emblems and National Identity The NOC code must be displayed on the back of shooting vests or outer garments worn by shotgun athletes.

National flags or NOC emblems [) may be placed on:

- The front of headgear (caps or visors).
