

Introduction

The International Visegrad Fund is a donor organization established in 2000 by the governments of the Visegrad Group countries – Czechia, Hungary, Poland and Slovakia.

The Fund follows the vision of President Vaclav Havel, President Lech Wałęsa and Prime Minister József Antall and supports regional cooperation of civil society organizations.

That is possible thanks to Grants, Scholarships and Artists Residencies.

Grants

Visegrad, Visegrad+ and Strategic Grants are seperate schemes that provide organizations with funding opportunities for their project ideas.

With grants, we seek to advance innovative ideas that address shared challenges by high quality regional cooperation projects.

- meaningful cooperation and active participation of organizations (balanced role of the partners and V4 balance)
- Bilateral cross-border cooperation at least 2 organizations from 2 neighboring V4 countries projects taking place within a 40-km radius from the border and focusing on a local issue
- Grants can cover up to 100% of project budget with 15% for overheads
- Projects must address at least one of the <u>focus areas</u>





- Workshop to help non-Ukrainian participants to by symphatetic and Ukrainina athletes themselves to easier cope with difficult experiences: historian József Kádár gave a lecture on the historical roots of the current Russian-Ukrainian conflict. The head coach of Serbian Womens's National Team, Dragana Ivković, tried to convey to the participating athletes how to find a way to withdraw from the negative effects of the war through sports. Psychologist Petra Drahota Szabó talked about the emotions and reactions which such a crisis related to the Russian war in Ukraine can evoke in us.

- Presentation of the civic association ZOM Prešov, BTC partners from V4 countries and BTC events to local governments and public in the Liptov region



What is V4 Gen Mini-Grant?



V4 Gen Mini-Grant supports short-term cross-border youth mobility in the V4 region and its immediate neighborhood in the age group 12–30. Proposals for the mini-grants must document that the projects will involve physical crossborder mobility.

Conditions for applying



Any legal entity relevant in working with youth and registered in V4 countries can apply for support.

Each project must involve at least two V4 countries (Czechia, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia) but can also include entities from direct neighbors of two V4 countries (i.e., Austria, Germany, and Ukraine).

The deadlines are three times a year always by 12:00 p. m. (noon) on March 15, July 15, and November 15.


Applying procedure

- Start with registration in the on-line system and prepare a brief project draft (read the questions and the notes carefully).
- Once your idea was accepted, finalize the entire application form and submit it by noon on a given deadline date.



Await the results (If supported \rightarrow confirm, sign the grant contract and start the project. If not supported \rightarrow request feedback and start anew).

Most frequent mistakes

- Missing the draft deadline date (2 weeks before the application deadline).
- Unbalanced number of participants.
- Unclear national composition of participants.
- Vague description of planned activities.
- The partners are not involved (no active engagement).
- No specific topic chosen (sightseeing is not a topic, but can be part of the program).



Project implementation

Duration of events and the whole project

Maximum three events (visits) are allowed within a project.

The length of each event is limited to 7 days.

In the cases of visits lasting longer (e.g., a 2-week summer school or a 10-day training), they can be entered as two separate, successive events.

The length of the implementation period is limited to 6 months.

Projects cannot start later than 4 months after each deadline.


In other words, every project shall be concluded within 10 months from application deadline.



Both events were designed as 2-day training camp and a 2-day competition combined with a family sports picnic for the local community and local traditions of their regions. Moreover, they could learn about the customs and traditions of the highlanders from Podhale in Poland as they watched a performance of a regional band.


