

WDSF – BREAKING







All General Principles apply unless expressly mentioned otherwise hereafter (in particular in relation to size, frequency or location). Please refer to the "Identifications on NOC Team Apparel Practical Guidelines", and General Guidelines (released Summer 2023) to obtain the general principles of Authorised Identifications on NOC uniforms at the Olympic Games. This section provides visual illustrations regarding the placement and size of Sport Specific Implementation for any items.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

The IOC has set up a new tool for items to be reviewed and offer assistance. The new Uniform Submission tool is now live on <u>RELAY</u>, where uniforms can be submitted to the IOC for review.

If you are a NOC who does not have access to RELAY and needs access to submit the uniforms, please email <u>nocnet@olympic.org</u>

All designs must be submitted to the WDSF for approval through <u>RELAY</u> at the latest **30 days before** each Olympic Games.

The uniforms for the competition should be provided for the WDSF officials for the approval prior the competitions.

Markings may be measured and checked by the WDSF officials for compliance while worn.

Any use of the logos not explicitly described in this document is prohibited.

No additional obligatory submission process required by the IF, **section 14** of the General Guidelines applies.

01 ATHLETE FRONT

Identification of the Manufacturer

Clothing

- T-shirt | Pants | Track Suit | Jacket
 One Identification of the Manufacturer [] per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm².
- Socks One Identification of the Manufacturer [] will be permitted, to a maximum size of 10cm².
- Sports bra | Underclothes One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm².

Accessories

Head accessories (cap, beanie, sweatband)
 Either one Identification of the Manufacturer []
 per item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 10cm² or two Identifications of the Manufacturer, to a maximum size of 5cm² each, placed above each ear.

The athlete illustration is for illustrative purposes only. If no identification is mentioned, there is no IF specific regulation

Glasses

Glasses may carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 months or more prior to the Games, with the Identifications permitted on the lenses so long as such identifications are tone-on-tone, engraved into the lens, and is not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC

Armbands
 One Identification of

One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [■]per item, with a maximum size of 6cm².

- Protective gear (Elbows, knees, wrists, and ankles protection) One Identification of the Manufacturer [] per item, with a maximum size of 6cm².
- Gloves

One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item, with a maximum size of 8cm².

Shoes/Footwear

Shoes

All footwear items may carry the *Identification of the Manufacturer* [**•**] as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of 6 months prier to the Games.

Product Technology Identification

Clothing

T-shirt | Pants | Track Suit | Jacket
 One additional *Product Technology Identification* [•] will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm².

NOC Emblem and National Identity

Additional IF Specifications

 No NOC emblem and/or National identity is required by the IF

The NOC code can appear on the right leg pants. The rules for the letters as per section 8 should apply. National marks can appear on jackets/t-shirts and pants. For more detailed information please refer to the WDSF Regulations.

Section 05

Third Party Identifications (athlete names)

The athlete's name may appear on the back of the T-shirt/Jacket/Track suit.

Should the name appear on the uniform the following rules should apply:

- Font: The recommended font type is *Blender*, although other similar fonts can also be used.
 Letters for the family name/nickname must be in upper case, unless the name is more than 9 letters, in which case lower case letters should be used following the first capital letter.
- Colour: If the uniform is a dark colour, the letters must be white. If the uniform is a light colour, the letters must be black.
- Position: The athlete's family name/nickname must be positioned above the NOC code bath on the front and back of the uniform. The family name on the uniform should correspond to the name in the competition data entry name.
- Size: The letters of the family name/nickname must measure between 8cm and 10cm high, and between 1cm and 1.5cm wide.

Section 07

NOC Emblems and National Identity

The NOC code can appear on the back of the T-shirt/ Jacket/Track suit. The letters must be in contrast color from the uniform (if the uniform is a dark colour, the letters must be white. If the uniform is in a light colour, the letters must be black), in capitals, between 8cm and 10cm high, and between 1cm and 1.5cm wide.

The NOC code can appear on the right leg pants. The rules for the letters as per section 8 should apply. National marks can appear on jackets/t-shirts and pants.
